Every person involved in club activities (<u>even if just once</u>) must be registered in the SSC membership database in one of the following categories:

Introductory	A new speed skater taking part in a "learn to skate" program (maximum 10 sessions) either consecutively or weekly. - Clubs can register long time members as Lifetime Associates (if a skater however, they must be retired). A one time fee of 200.00 to SSC will be applied. Neither SSC nor BC will charge associate fees for such a member after the one time payment has been made.
- All fees (provincial and national) will be paid to the BCSSA. BCSSA will issue invoices in October, January and March.
- Clubs will be billed the annual \$100 BCSSA affiliation fee with the October invoice (passed at the 2014 BCSSA AGM).
