- Skating Equipment:** All skaters are required to wear equipment as per SSC Procedures and Regulations D3-100. Please note the following:
- All skaters are required to wear shatter resistant protective sport glasses (clear or yellow are recommended) or a complete visor. Glasses must be held in place by an elastic strap.
  - Helmets must have a seal of certification meeting the ASTM F1849 Standards. Active Start and FUNdamentals skaters may use CSA-approved hockey, snowboard/ski or skateboard helmets (no bicycle helmets permitted).
  - All skaters must have cut-resistant covering at the ankle.

<p><b>Zone 2 BCWG U14 Male</b> Male skaters who live in Zone 2 and are 12 or 13 years old as of June 30, 2017.</p>	100m	200m, 400m and 1500m
<p><b>Zone 2 BCWG U16 Female</b> Female skaters who live in Zone 2 and are 14 or 15 years old as of June 30, 2017.</p>	111.12m	500m, 1000m and 1500m
<p><b>Zone 2 BCWG U16 Male</b> Male skaters who live in Zone 2 and are 14 or 15 years old as of June 30, 2017.</p>	111.12m	500m, 1000m and 1500m
<p><b>Regional B</b> Young skaters who are new to speed skating competition.</p>	100m	50m and 200m
<p><b>Regional A</b> Young skaters who have some speed skating competitive experience.</p>	100m	200m and 800m
<p><b>Provincial C</b> Grade school aged recreational and competitive speed skaters.</p>	100m	200m, 400m and 1200m
<p><b>Provincial B**</b> Grade school aged to teenaged competitive speed skaters.</p>	100m	200m, 400m and 1500m
<p><b>Provincial A**</b> Teenaged skaters transitioning to elite speed skating.</p>	100m and 111.12m	400m (100m), 500m (111.12m) and 1500m (100m)
<p><b>Performance</b> Teenaged and young adult elite speed skaters.</p>	111.12m	500m, 1000m and 1500m
<p><b>Competitive for Life</b> Teenaged to masters speed skaters who enjoy lifelong competition.</p>	111.12m	500m and 1000m
