Re: 2017-18 Year End Tasks Officials Development

As the end of the 2017-18 season is approaching rapidly, BCSSA ODC would like to thank every official for the involvement this past year. Without your commitment we could not have successfully hosted competitions. We also like to thank every meet coordinator and referee for submitting the required reports. These provide valuable feedback on issues that may need addressing. If you have not yet done, take a minute or two and do so.

We also need to start wrapping things up and planning for next year. These include

- (a) accrediting and upgrading officials;
- (b) updating the current list of officials; and
- (c) identifying clinics for the 2018-2019 year.

We like to stress that the responsibility to submit requests rests with the individual who wishes to be accredited or upgraded. Here is what is involved.

ACCREDITATION AND UPGRADING OFFICIALS

BCSSA ODC reviews the requests of officials for (1) **Level 1 accreditation**, and (2) **Upgrading** to Level 2.

BCSSA ODC also reviews requests from Level 2 Officials for upgrading to Level 3. We recommend these upgrades to SSC ODC.

If you are interested in being accredited or upgraded, it is important to follow the guidelines and submit your request with documentation to BCSSA ODC by March 31, 2018
